Paraffinum Liquidum, Honey, Petrolatum, Water, Cetearyl Alcohol, Polysorbate 80, Alcohol Denatured, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Sodium Cetearyl Sulfate, Lavandula Angustifolia Oil, Melaleuca Viridiflora Leaf Oil, Ocimum Basilicum Oil, Pogostemon Cablin Leaf Oil, Thymus Vulgaris Flower / Leaf Oil, Potassium Sorbate, Citric Acid.

Recommended Use

Vetramil® improves the condition of the skin and supports the natural skin recovery process in domestic animals and pets.

Product Performance

Vetramil® is a honey-based ointment with essential oils. The ointment softens and protects the skin. Vetramil® contains honey with natural enzymes. The enzymes in the honey are purifying and are beneficial for a healthy skin condition. The low pH of Vetramil® helps to protect the skin against external threats, the bitter taste of the essential oils prevent animals from licking the ointment.

Directions for Use

1. If necessary, clean the skin with water and pat dry with clean tissue.
2. Apply Vetramil® 1-2 times per day.
3. Massage well onto the skin.
4. Vetramil® may be combined with a gauze dressing.
5. Continue treatment until the skin has reached a good condition.

Precautions

- Do not use the ointment if the packaging is damaged.
- Close the packaging after use.
- Avoid contamination of the contents.
- Use the contents within 3 months after opening.
- There is no withdrawal period after the application of Vetramil®.
- After opening some liquid can come out of the tube. Small quantities of natural oils can separate from the ointment during storage. This process has no effect on the performance of the product.

Storage

Store between 39 °F / 4 °C and 86 °F / 30 °C.
